




After extensive effort and consultation, Koro Creek together with the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries launched an intriguing project on the estate 13 March 2025, introducing a biological control agent for lantana known as the lantana flower gall mite.

Cuttings from an infected plant sourced from the Tzaneen area were strategically placed and secured onto the stems of plants in the phase 4 area of the estate. Although the initial sample was small, significant effort, patience, and monitoring will be essential to facilitate the mite's spread.

The team is enthusiastic and committed to ensuring the project's success, recognizing the potential impact of the mite on controlling lantana growth.

Sandbagging and Handicap Rule for MLS in Betterball Competitions This week, we focus on sandbagging and the importance of maintaining fairness in competition. Sandbagging refers to intentionally misrepresenting your handicap to gain an advantage. Remember, integrity is at the core of our game.

The MLS (Most Likely Score) rule ensures accuracy when calculating scores in Betterball or team competitions. If your ball isn't holed, record the strokes you're likely to have taken under normal circumstances to complete the hole—this keeps handicaps fair and equitable for everyone.

# THIS MONTH'S RULES TO FOCUS ON

IN THIS MONTHS EDITION A REMINDER OF THE FOLLOWING RULES
TO TAKE NOTE OF.

#### 1. Dear Homeowners and Residents,

We have noticed a few instances where underage children, without adult supervision, have been driving golf carts around the estate.

As a reminder, for the safety of all residents, please be reminded that, as per the estate rules, this is strictly prohibited.

Parents allowing this behavior may face stringent penalties. For your safety and the safety of your children, we urge you to adhere to this rule to prevent any serious incidents.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Extracted from the HOA Rules.

3.3.12. Any person who operates any motorized vehicle must have a valid drivers license. Any person with a learners license can operate a motorized vehicle under the supervision of a person with a valid drivers license. All motorbikes and motorized scooters are to be operated at generally acceptable noise levels. They shall be roadworthy and licensed, and riders shall wear helmets and shall be licensed to drive such vehicles. No motorized vehicle of any kind shall be allowed on the public walkways, except for security vehicles. Quad bikes in any form are strictly prohibited to be operated on any part of the estate except for security personnel performing patrolling duties. In the case of private golf carts these may only be operated by persons with a valid drivers or learners license. Persons without a valid drivers or learners license may only operate these golf carts under adult supervision which have a valid drivers license. The said adult accepts all liabilities for injury and damage to property. All Koro Creek's golf carts may only be operated by persons with a valid drivers license in all areas of the estate;

# THIS MONTH'S RULES TO FOCUS ON

2. Please note that dumping of garden refuse is not permitted anywhere on the estate, it needs to be disposed of correctly. We ask that you do not dump refuse of any kind in adjoining land or green belts. This issue will be monitored and we ask for your cooperation and understanding.

Extracted from the HOA Rules.

- 3.3.5. Littering and dumping anywhere on the Property are strictly prohibited;
- 3.4.8.12. No dumping or littering of any nature including but not limited to building material, garden and household refuse is permitted anywhere on the estate.
- 4.2.4.9.26. Domestic waste in black bags must be placed within wheelie refuse bin.
- 3. Drones are not allowed to fly over private property within Koro Creek Bushveld Golf Estate without the owner's written consent. The HOA office must be notified in advance of any planned drone operations. Recreational drone use is strictly prohibited. Operators must comply with all aviation regulations and respect residents' privacy. Unauthorized drone use may result in penalties. For approvals or inquiries, please contact the HOA office.
- 4. For your safety and the safety of your domestic workers, please note that they are **NOT permitted** to cross the golf course when entering or exiting the estate.

All residents and their staff must use the designated roads and pathways to ensure safety and to prevent accidents.
